2022- 2023 AFEW KENYA- GIRAFFE CENTRE SCHOOLS ADMISSION PROTOCOL

1. NO SCHOOL/ CHURCH GROUP WILL BE ADMITTED WITHOUT BOOKING WETHER WEEKDAY OR WEEKEND.

2. All learning institutions will be required to make a prior booking through writing to education@giraffecentre.org or calling +254 (0) 20807804, +254 (0) 723786165, +254 (0) 734890952 at least two weeks before visiting.

3. All Schools should confirm their booking at least one week before

visiting by calling the above official Giraffe Centre lines.

 Booked groups should keep to the date and time schedule issued or notify the Giraffe Centre of any changes on the earliest date possible.

 Booked schools will be admitted free entry for all students and 4 teachers. Additional teachers should pay Kshs 400 through the AFEW's general visitors ticketing system

 Only 10 schools will be admitted per day on Monday- Friday 9.00am-2.00pm on a first book first come basis. Each school will be booked to

bring a maximum of 100 students only per day

7. ALL schools admitted to Giraffe Centre will be given a conservation talk, meet the giraffes and upper primary taken to the Demonstration site and Nature trail. Schools will also receive conservation posters and fill evaluation form to leave behind.

 Only 5 schools/ church groups will be admitted on Saturday- Sunday 9.00am- 12.00 noon on a first book first come basis and each student

will pay Kshs 200 and each teacher Kshs 400.

All payments are to be made through MPESA or Debit/ Credit Cards at the Giraffe Centre Ticketing office

10. No individual student photos for school/ church groups
