As part of our education conservation programmes we host more than 50,000 students and teachers every year.

In order to serve you better please take note of the following guidelines and associated conservation fees for Kenya based learning institutions and other organised groups visiting the centre as outlined below;


All learning institutions will be required to make a prior booking at least one month in advance only by calling to AFEW'S Education Department Contact- +254 723 786 165 or +254 734 890 952 or walk in before visiting. Email booking for schools will not be accepted. All bookings must be confirmed at least one week prior to admission through calling the Organization.

Tertiary Institutions (Colleges/ University Students) booking through the institution	Monday-Sunday 0900hrs-1400hrs	Kenyan	Kshs 200 each per student and Kshs 400 per tutor. Payment will made as a donation through the AFEW's general visitors ticketing system. Must show student cards.
Learning Institutions/ youth groups from East Africa	Monday- Sunday 0900hrs- 1400 hrs	Uganda/Congo, Rwanda/ Burundi/ Tanzania	Normal visitor daily entry fees rates will apply. Book through the AFEW's general visitors ticketing system

1. **NO SCHOOL WILL BE ADMITTED WITHOUT BOOKING WHETHER WEEKDAY OR WEEKEND.**
2. Booked groups should keep to the number of students booked, date and time schedule issued or notify the Giraffe Centre of any changes on the earliest date possible. **No admission of Schools coming on non-booked date or excess students.**
3. Only 3 schools will be admitted per day on Monday- Friday 9.00am- 12.00 noon on a first book first come basis. Each booked school will bring a maximum of 200 students only per day.
4. ALL schools admitted to Giraffe Centre will be given a conservation talk, meet the giraffes and upper primary taken to the Demonstration site and Nature trail. Schools will also receive conservation posters and fill evaluation form to leave behind.
5. All payments are to be made through MPESA or Debit/ Credit Cards at the Giraffe Centre Ticketing office
6. No individual student photos for school groups at Giraffe Platform
